To create a Morse Code & Semaphore Card for your wallet or Survival Kit, follow these directions:

- 1. Print this page.
- 2. Cut out the above graphic.
- 3. Fold the graphic in half so that Morse Code is on one side and Semaphore is on the other side.
- 4. Laminate the folded graphic to waterproof it.

At one time the requirements for First Class Scout included passing a test for Morse Code and Semaphore. This is no longer a requirement. Morse Code and Semaphore remain as two forms of communication that could be lifesaving value in a survival situation.

With this in mind, BSA Troop 204, Foothills District of the Atlanta Area Council provides this card to all Scouts as part of their required Survival Kit.
